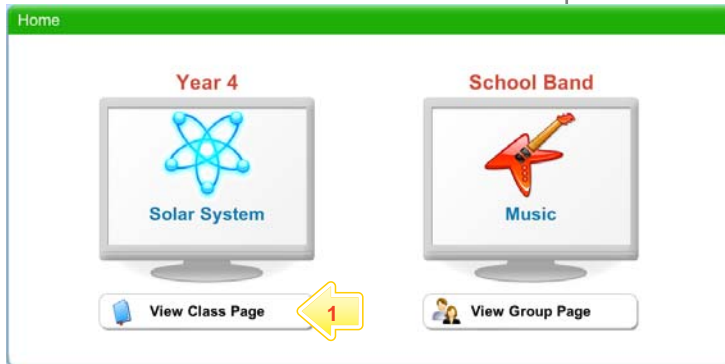


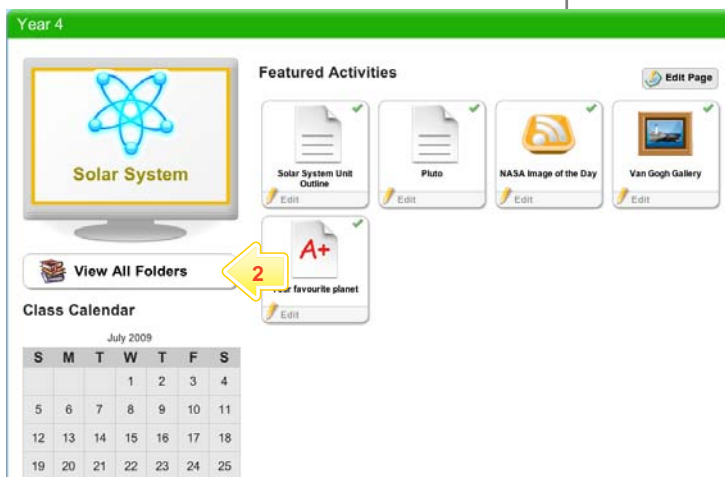
# Create a Folder

## Create a new Folder

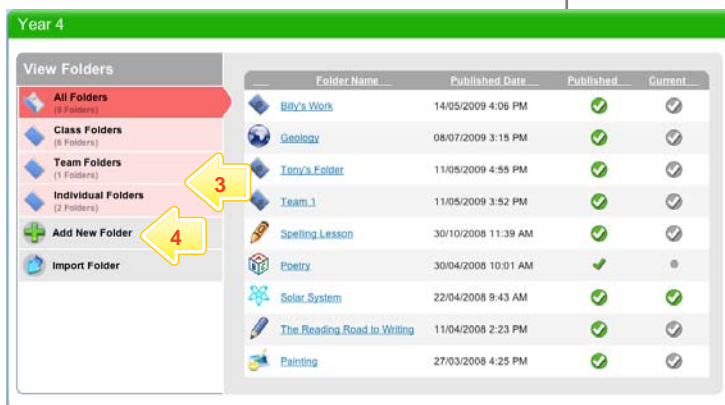
Learning content for a Class or Group is presented in Folders.



- 1 Below the Class or Group in which you want to create the Folder, click the **View Class Page** button.



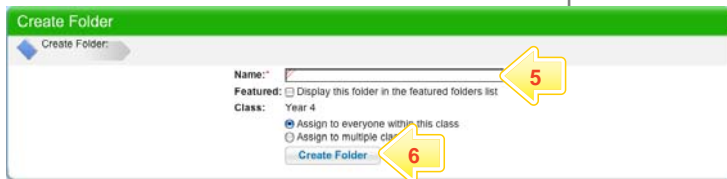
- 2 Click the **View All Folders** button.



- 3 If you want to create a Team Folder or an Individual Folder, click the appropriate tab.

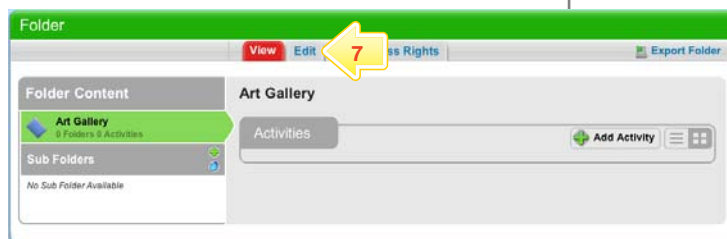
- 4 Click the **Add New Folder** button.

# Create a Folder

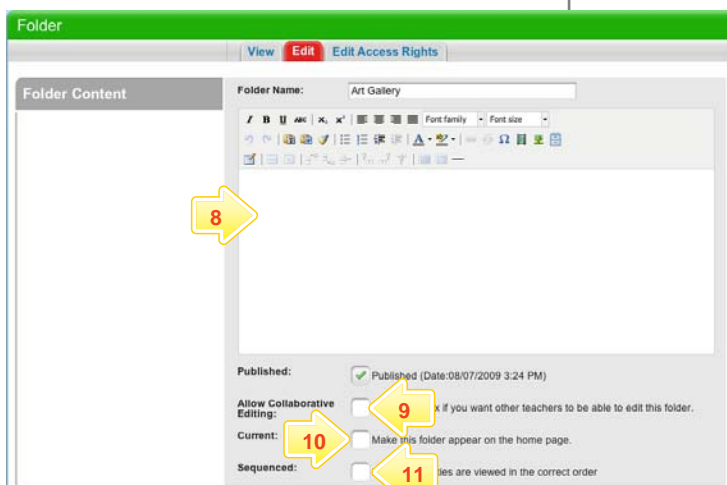


5 In the **Name** field, type a name for the Folder.

6 Click **Create Folder**.



7 If you want to add more information for the folder, click the **Edit** tab.

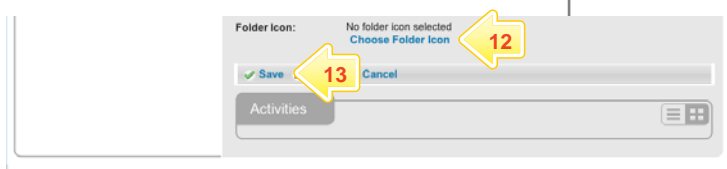


8 If you want to add a folder description, type it in the text field.

9 If you want to **Allow Collaborative Editing**, ensure that the checkbox is selected.

10 If you want the folder to be the current folder, select the **Current** checkbox.

11 If you want the activities in the folder to be sequenced, select the **Sequenced** checkbox.



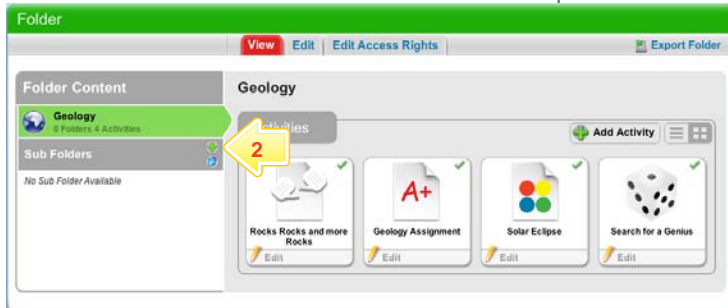
12 If you want to choose a folder icon, click **Choose Folder Icon** and click the icon that you want to use.

13 Click **Save**.

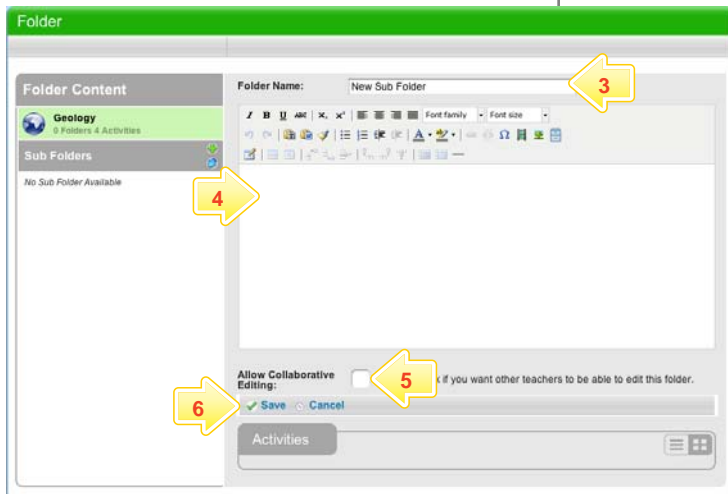
# Create a Folder

## Add a Sub Folder

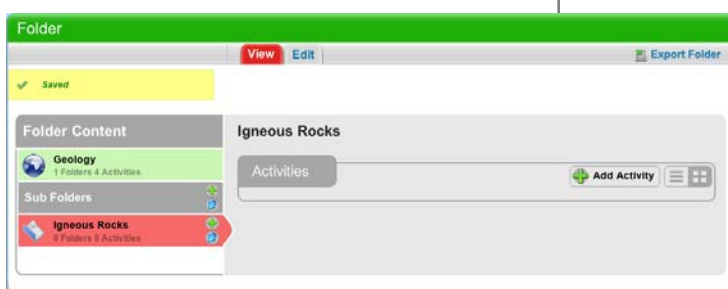
There can be any number of Sub Folders within a Folder. Use Sub Folders to organise Activities.



- 1 Open the Folder to which you want to add a Sub Folder.
- 2 Click **Add New**.



- 3 In the **Name** field, type a name for the Folder.
- 4 In the **Description** field, type a description of the Folder.
- 5 If you want to **Allow Collaborative Editing**, ensure that the checkbox is selected.
- 6 Click **Save**.



The new folder opens.

**Hint** To add Activities to the folder click the **Add Activity** button.

## Tips and Hints

- 1 Copy whole Folders or Sub Folders by exporting them to your eLocker. From your eLocker you can then re-import them into another Class or Group.
