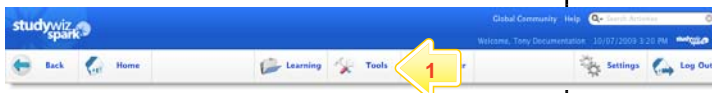


Learning Plans

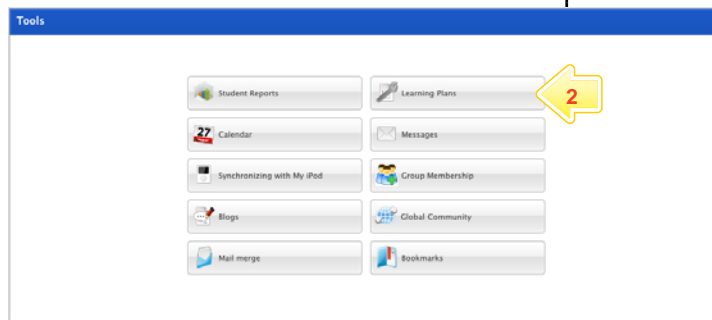


Create a new Learning Plan

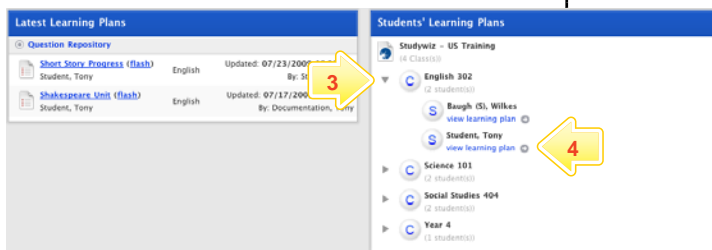
Learning Plans let Students develop a strategy for learning about a particular topic. Teachers and Parents can view and can contribute to their Students' Learning Plans. A Learning Plan is typically used to guide a Student through a long term project with clearly defined goals. Learning Plans are presented through a fun interactive Flash interface with a choice of different templates, or through a text based interface.



1 Click the **Tools** button.



2 Click the **Learning Plans** button.

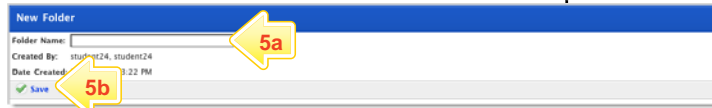


3 Click ► to expand a class.

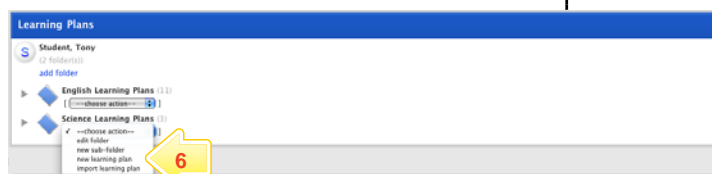
4 Adjacent to the name of the student for whom you want to create the learning plan, click **view learning plan**.



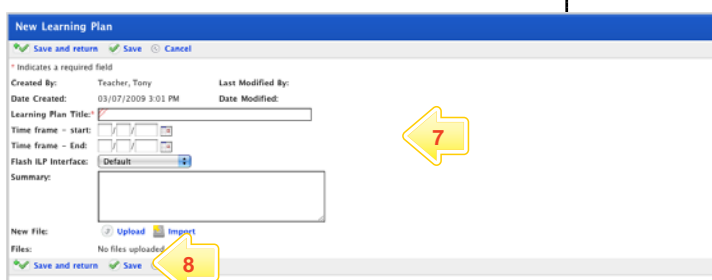
5 If there are no learning plan folders, click the **add folder** button.



- a Enter a folder name.
- b Click **Save**. The new folder is added.



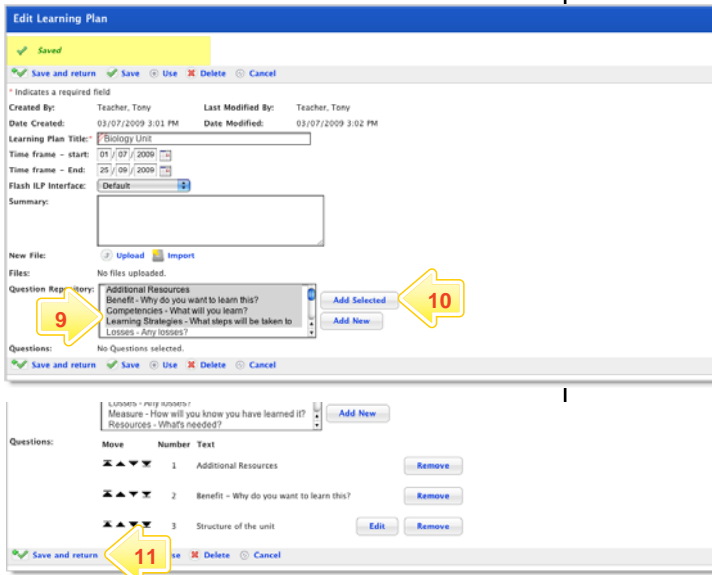
6 From the **--choose action--** drop-down list, select **new learning plan**.



7 Enter the Learning Plan information.

8 Click **Save**. The Question Repository appears.

9 From the **Question Repository** field select the questions that you want to add to the Learning Plan.

10 Click **Add Selected**. The questions are added at the bottom of the panel.

Hint Click **Add New** to create a new question.

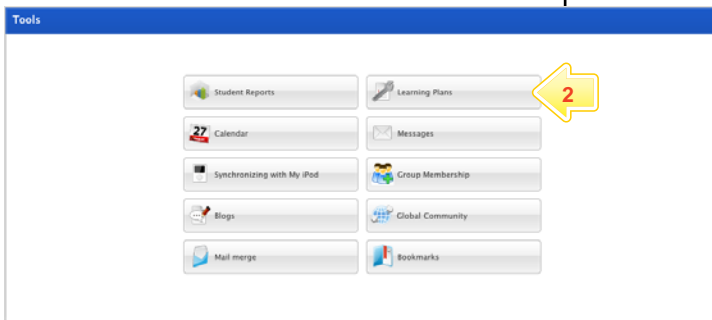
Hint Click the up and down arrows to re-order the questions.

11 Click **Save and return**.

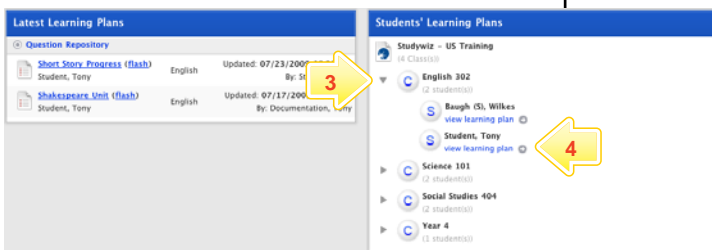
Contribute to a Learning Plan



1 Click the **Tools** button.

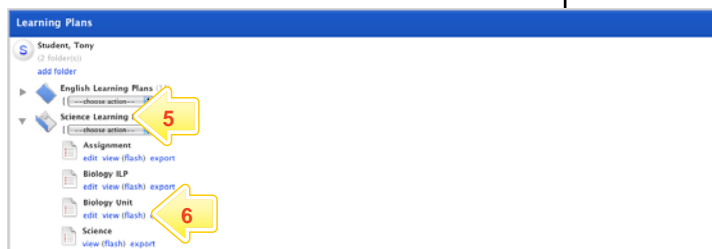


2 Click the **Learning Plans** button. The Latest ILPs and Learning Plans panels appear.



3 Click ► to expand a class.

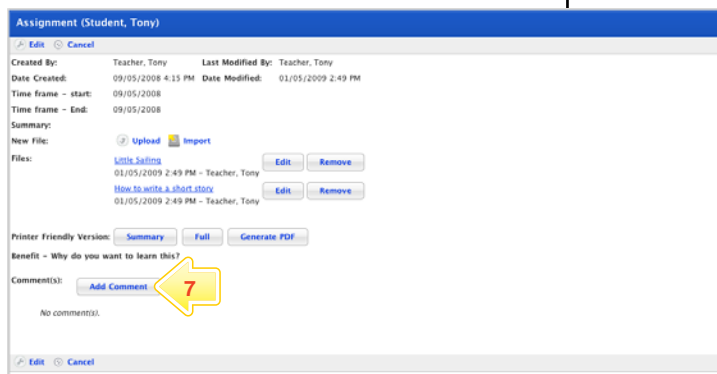
4 Adjacent to the name of the student whose learning plan you want to view, click **view learning plan**.



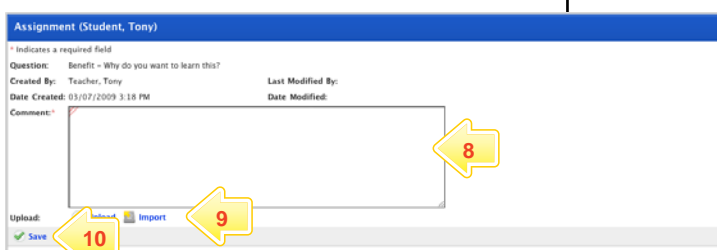
5 Click the ► to expand the Learning Plans folder.

6 Click **view**.

Hint To view the Learning Plan in a flash interface, click the **(flash)** link.



7 For each question, click the **Add Comment** button.



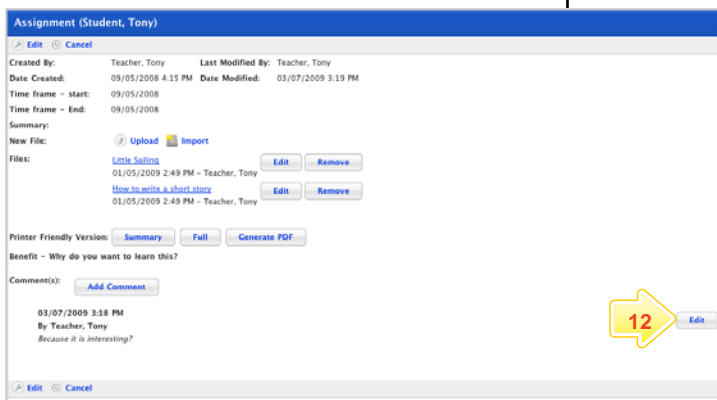
8 Enter comments, suggestions, an answer or a plan for how to answer the question.

9 Click **Upload** or **Import** to add a file to the Learning Plan question (optional).

10 Click **Save**.



11 Click the StudyWiz Spark **Back** tab. The Learning Plan reappears and displays the new comments.



12 Edit a comment by clicking the **Edit** button.

Tips and Hints

- 1** Upload or import any kind of file into a Learning Plan, for example, students can upload a piece of work or even a video blog as a reflection.
- 2** Encourage students to take control of their own Learning Plans.
- 3** Check students' Learning Plans progress regularly.
- 4** Leave comments for students in the Learning Plans.
- 5** Encourage Parents to log in and see their students' Learning Plans.
