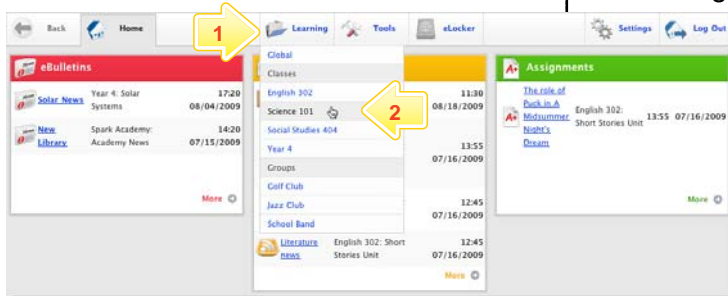


# Poll

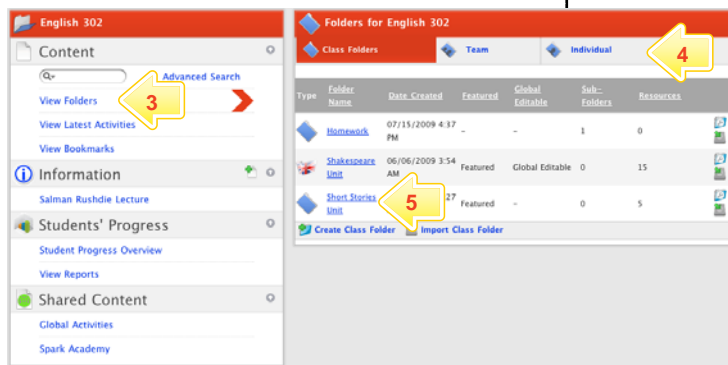
## Create a Poll

Studywiz Spark Polls allow you to pose a single question with a number of teacher-set answers. Users view the poll and select their answer from the answer list. Studywiz Spark compiles the results and teachers can view the statistics of the Poll. A user may only cast their vote once and voting is anonymous.



1 Roll the mouse pointer over the **Learning** tab. The **Learning** drop-down list appears.

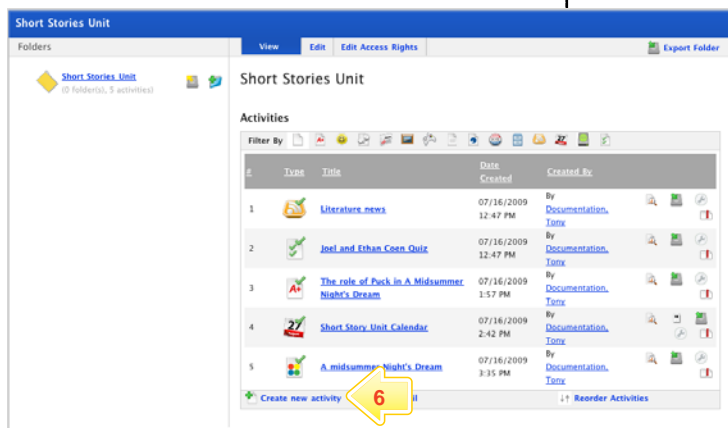
2 From the **Learning** drop-down, select the Class or Group in which you want to save the activity. The Class or Group page appears.



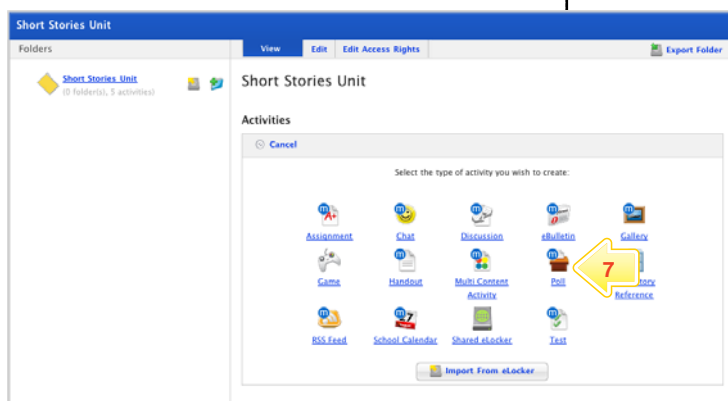
3 Click **View Folders**.

4 If you want to create the activity in a Team folder or Individual folder, click the appropriate tab.

5 Click the folder in which you want to save the activity.



6 Click **Create new Activity**.



7 Click **Poll**.

# Poll

The 'New Poll' form includes the following fields and options:

- 8**: From and To date/time pickers.
- 9**: Title, Question, and Short Description text boxes.
- 10**: 'Create polls closed date' link.
- 11**: 'Display Results' checkbox.
- 12**: 'Add Answer' button.
- 13**: 'Featured Activities' checkbox.
- 14**: 'Publish' checkbox.
- 15**: 'Save' button.

- 8** In the **From** and **To** fields, set the times and dates between which you want the Poll to be accessible.
- 9** Complete the **Title**, **Question**, **Short Description** and **Keywords** fields. Separate keywords with spaces or commas.
- 10** If you want to select a date for the Poll to close, click the **Create polls closed date** link and then set a closing date.
- 11** If you want users to be able to see the results after they have cast their poll, select the **Display Results** checkbox.
- 12** Add answers in the **Possible Answers** fields. To add additional answers click the **Add Answer** button.
- 13** To set the Poll as a featured activity, select the **Featured Activities** checkbox.
- 14** If the Poll is ready to publish, select the **Publish** checkbox.
- 15** Click **Save**.

- 1** Locate and click the Poll you want to view. The Poll panel appears.
