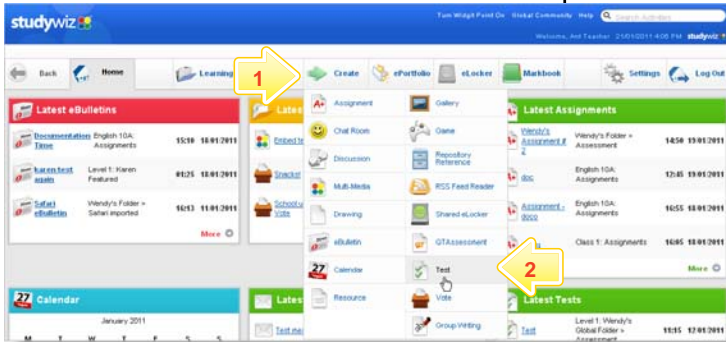


Test

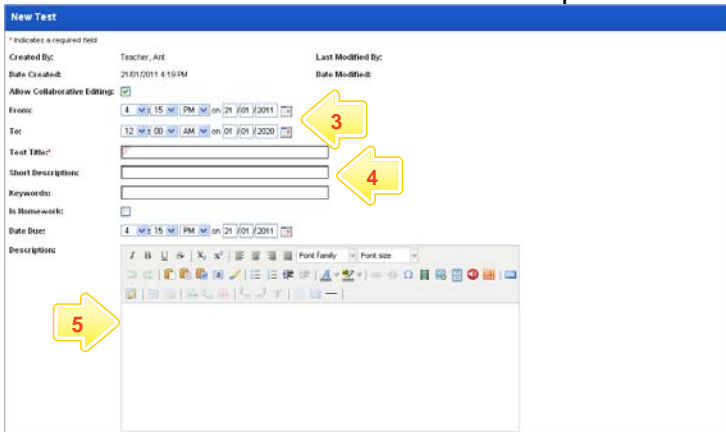
Create a Test

StudyWiz Tests have several question types, configurable options and produce comprehensive reports on your students' results. You can set a test to be taken once, or allow your students multiple attempts.



1 Roll the mouse pointer over the **Create** tab. The Activity list appears.

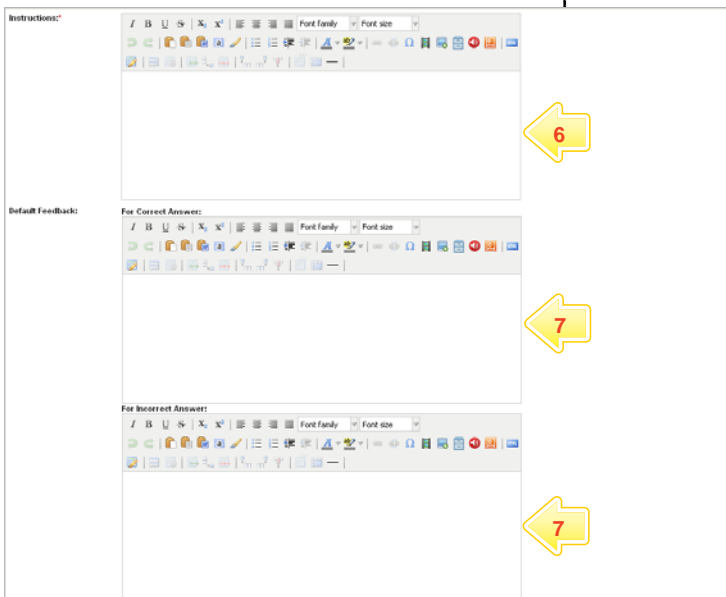
2 Click **Test**. The New Test panel appears.



3 In the **From** and **To** fields, set the times and dates between which you want the Test to be available.

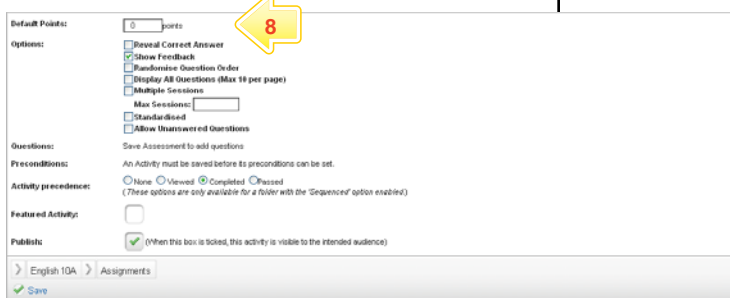
4 Complete the **Title**, **Short Description** and **Keywords** fields. Separate keywords with spaces or commas.

5 In the **Description** field write a description of the Test.



6 In the **Instructions** field, type the instructions for the Test.

7 In the **Default Feedback** fields, type the feedback for a correct and an incorrect answer for the questions.



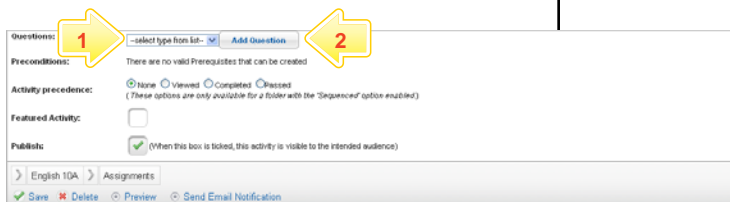
8 In the **Default Points** field, type the points for each correct answer.

9 Select or deselect the **Options** checkboxes to suit your needs for the Test.

Hint Use the breadcrumb to change the Activity's location.

10 Click **Save**. The Test is saved and the Questions and Prerequisites options are enabled.

Add a Question

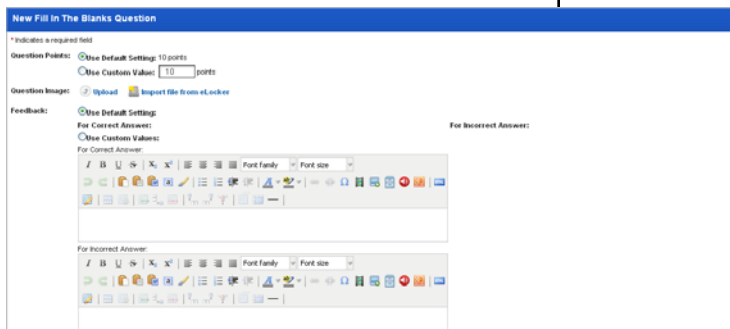


1 From the **Questions** drop-down list, select the type of question you wish to use.

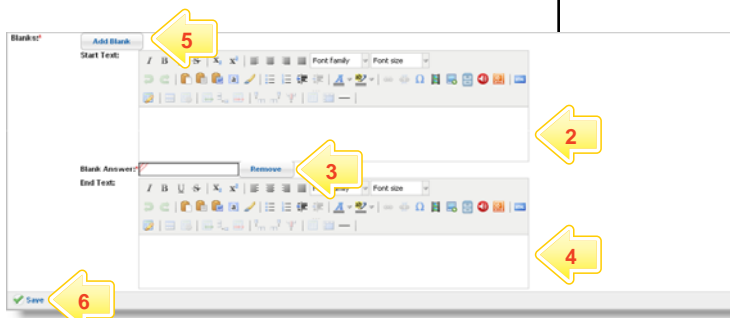
2 Click the **Add Question** button. Instructions for each question type are provided in the sections below.

Fill in the Blanks

A Fill in the Blanks question presents a sentence or a series of sentences to students with one or more words missing. Students answer by filling in the missing words.



1 Complete the **Question Points**, **Question Image** and **Feedback** fields.



2 In the **Start Text** field, type the first part of the statement.

3 In the **Blank Answer** field, type the part of the statement that the students must enter.

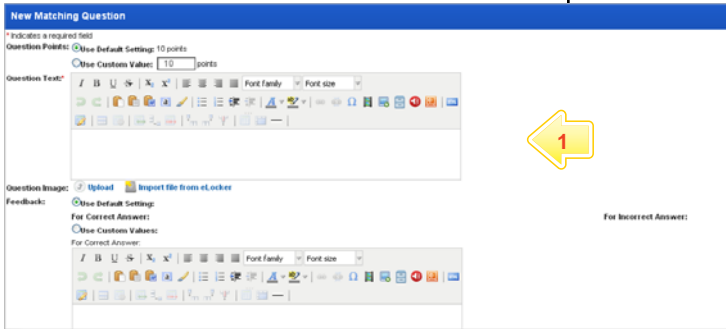
4 In the **End Text** field, type the last part of the statement.

5 If you want more than one blank in the question, click the **Add Blank** button.

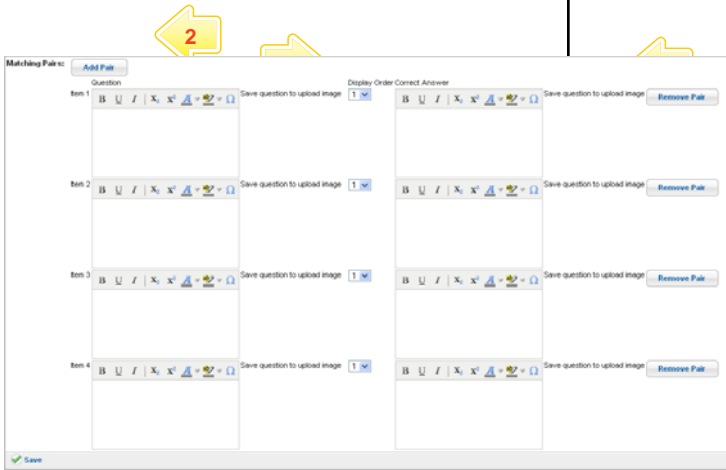
6 Click **Save**. The question is saved and is added to the Test.

Matching

A Matching question presents two numbered lists to students. Students match the items in the first list with the items in the second.



1 Complete the **Question Points**, **Question Image**, **Feedback** and **Question Text** fields.



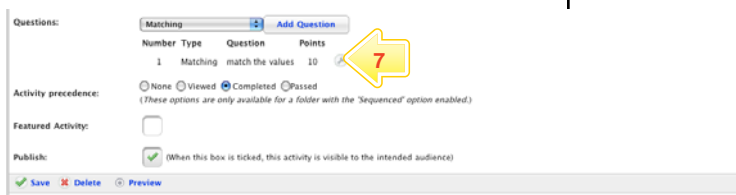
2 Set up the number of matching pairs you need by clicking **Add Answer** or **Remove**.

3 In the **List 1** fields, type the items that will appear in the first list. These items will appear in the order displayed on this page.

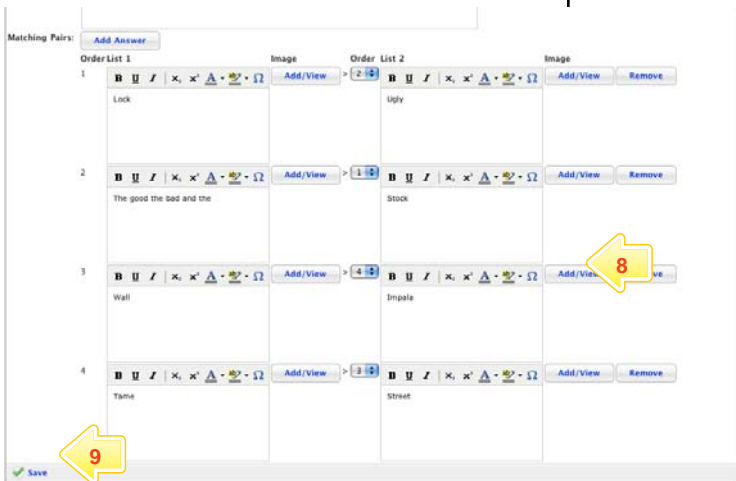
4 In the **List 2** fields, type the Items that will appear in the second list. Ensure that these items are adjacent to their matching items in List 1.

5 Use the **Order** drop-down lists to select the order in which the List 2 items will appear.

6 Click **Save**. The question is saved and is added to the Test. The Edit Test page appears.



7 To add images for the question, click the **Edit** question button adjacent to the question.



8 Add images to each item in each list by clicking the **Add/View** buttons and navigating to suitable images.

9 Click **Save**.

Multiple Answer

A Multiple Answer question allows you to pose a question and have students select one or more correct answers from a list.

- 1 Complete the **Question Text** and the **Feedback** fields.
- 2 Add Image, Audio or Video files as needed.
- 3 Decide how many answers you need and adjust by clicking the **Add Answer** or **Remove** buttons.
- 4 In the **Answer Value** fields, type the possible answers to your question.
- 5 For each correct answer (you may have more than one) select the **Correct Answer** checkbox.
- 6 For each correct answer, in the **Point Value** fields, enter the number of points that will be awarded.
- 7 Click **Save**. The question is saved.
- 8 To add images for the question, click the **Edit** question button adjacent to the question.
- 9 Add images to each item in each list by clicking the **Add/View** buttons and navigating to suitable images.
- 10 Click **Save**.

Multiple Choice

A Multiple Choice question allows you to pose a question and have students select one correct answer from a list.

- 1 Complete the **Question Points** and **Question Text** fields.
- 2 Upload or import a question image, audio or video.
- 3 Complete the **Feedback** fields.

- 4 Decide how many answers you need and adjust using the **Add Answer** and **Remove** buttons.
- 5 In the **Answer Value** fields, type the possible answers to your question.
- 6 For the correct answer, select the **Correct Answer** option.
- 7 Click **Save**. The question is saved and is added to the test. The Edit Test page appears.

- 8 To add answer images for the question, click the **Edit** question button adjacent to the question. The Edit Multiple Choice Question panel appears.

- 9 Click the **Add/View** buttons and navigate to suitable images.
- 10 Click **Save**.

Tips and Hints

- 1 Click the **Preview** button in the bottom left hand corner of the **Edit Test** panel to view the Test as students will see it.
- 2 If you are using images and do not want text in a field, simply use a space or stop to 'fill' the field.
- 3 In Studywiz Tests you can use a range of file types including MP3 sound files, video and JPEG images. Keep file sizes small so that the Test loads quickly.
- 4 Set a prerequisite for a Test by clicking the **Add Prerequisite** button. This allows you to specify another Test or a QTAassessment that your students must complete before they can attempt the new activity.
- 5 Use a multiple choice Test as an end of unit evaluation by using a rating scale as the possible answers for students to select from.
