

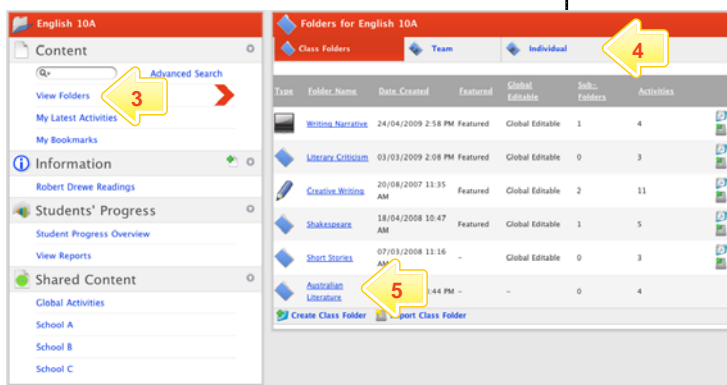
Create a new Resource

The Studywiz Resource feature allows you to load virtually any type of file into Studywiz. Other users can then download the file or copy it to their eLocker.



1 Roll the mouse pointer over the **Learning** tab. The **Learning** drop-down list appears.

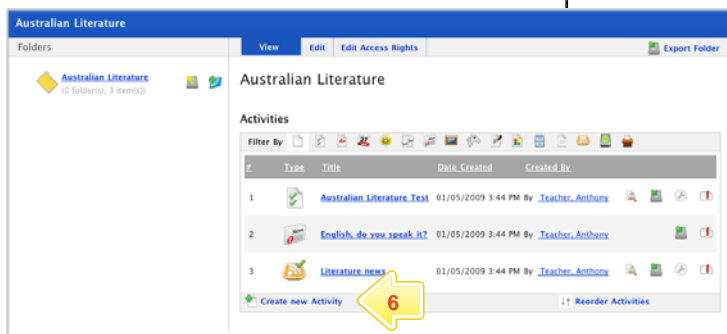
2 From the **Learning** drop-down, select the Class or Group in which you want to save the activity.



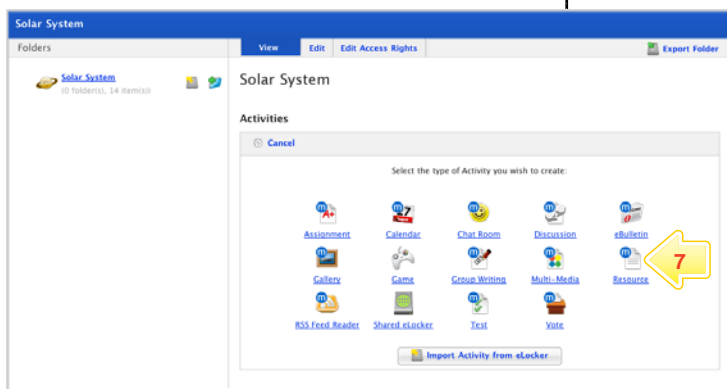
3 Click **View Folders**.

4 If you want to create the activity in a Team folder or Individual folder, click the appropriate tab.

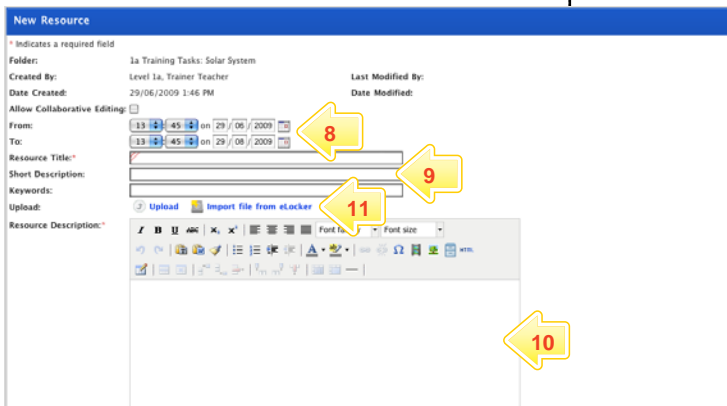
5 Click the folder in which you want to save the activity.



6 Click **Create new Activity**.



7 Click **Resource**.



- 8 In the **From** and **To** fields, set the times and dates between which you want the activity to be available.
- 9 Complete the **Title**, **Short Description** and **Keywords** fields. Separate keywords with spaces or commas.
- 10 Enter a **Resource Description**.
- 11 Click **Upload** or **Import From eLocker**.
 - If you are uploading a file, navigate to the file location, select the item and click the **Upload** button.
 - If you are importing a file from your eLocker, locate the file and click the **Import from eLocker** button

The Edit Resource page appears.

You can now preview, edit or remove the resource.



- 12 To set the Resource as a featured activity, select the **Featured Activity** checkbox.
- 13 If the Resource is ready to publish, select the **Publish** checkbox.
- 14 Click **Save**. The Resource is saved.

Tips and Hints

- 1 Use the Studywiz Resource activity to deliver resources to students while a class is in progress.
- 2 Upload a numbered series of files that students can open and use in order during a class. This makes it easy to make sure that your students are looking at the right material at the right time.
- 3 Cut and paste notes into the Description area to get information to students quickly.
