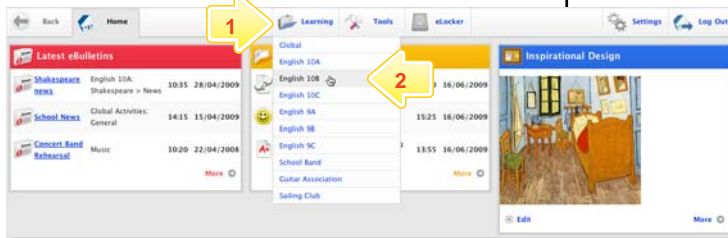


Multi-Media

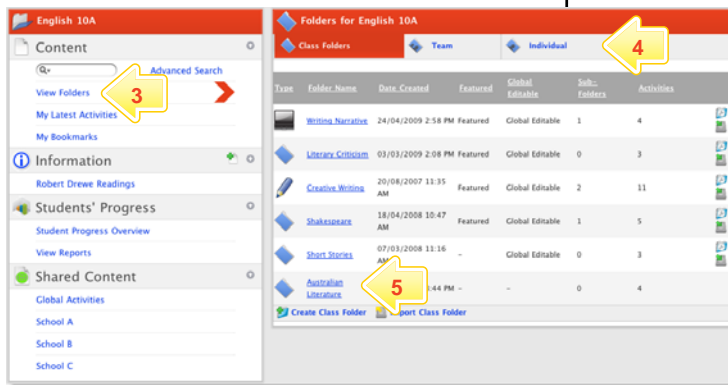
Create a new Multi-Media Activity

With the Studywiz Multi-Media Activity you can upload just about any kind of text, image, audio, video and link.



1 Roll the mouse pointer over the **Learning** tab. The **Learning** drop-down list appears.

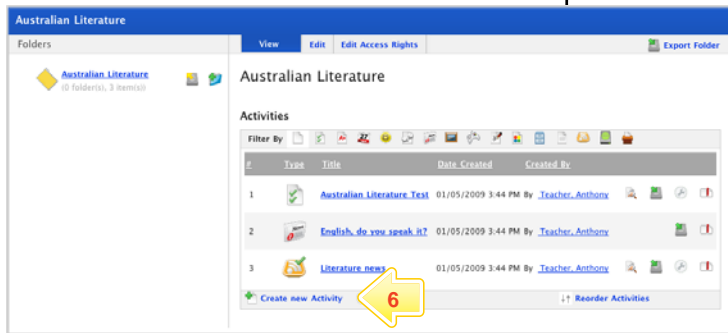
2 From the **Learning** drop-down, select the Class or Group in which you want to save the activity. The Class or Group page appears.



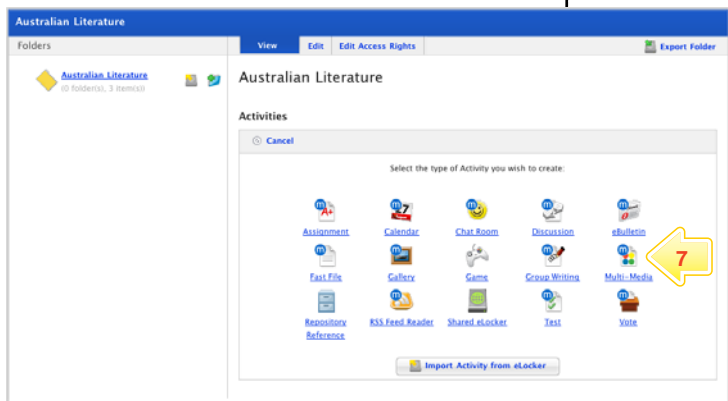
3 Click **View Folders**.

4 If you want to create the activity in a Team folder or an Individual folder, click the appropriate tab.

5 Click the folder in which you want to save the activity.



6 Click **Create new Activity**.



7 Click **Multi-Media**.

- 8 In the **From** and **To** fields, set the times and dates between which you want the activity to be available.
- 9 Complete the **Multi-Media Title**, **Short Description** and **Keywords** fields. Separate keywords with spaces or commas.
- 10 To set the Multi-Media as a featured activity, select the **Featured Activity** checkbox.
- 11 If the activity is ready to publish, select the **Publish** checkbox.
- 12 Click **Save**.

The **Associate Events** section also appears. This enables you to set an **Activity Start** and an **Activity End** date on a class calendar.

Add Content to the Activity

You add content to the Multi-Media Activity in content blocks. A content block can contain text, a link, an uploaded file, a media file, or an embedded video.

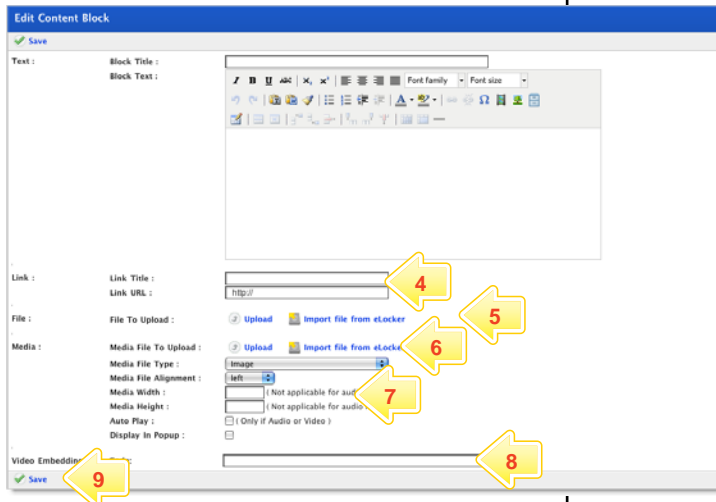

- 1 Open the Edit Content Block page:
 - a To add content to the default content block, click the **Edit Block** button. The Edit Content Block page appears.
 - b To add an additional content block, click the **Add Block** button. The Edit Content Block page appears.

For each piece of content that you want to include, use the area of the content block that matches the content type:

- 3 Enter a **Block Title** and **Block Text**.
- Hint** Use the Rich Text Editor to format the **Block Text**.



Link

- 4 Enter a **Link Title**, which users will see on the screen, and a **Link URL**, which is the location to which users will be taken.

File

Note Files are documents such as PDF, Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Keynote and Pages.

- 5 Click **Upload**, then locate the file you want on a hard drive, **or** Click **Import From eLocker** and import the file from your eLocker.

Media

- 6 Click **Upload**, then locate the file you want on a hard drive, **or** Click **Import From eLocker** and import the file from your eLocker.

Note Don't add more than one movie, image or audio to a Media content block. If you want to include more than one piece of media, put each one in its own content block.

- 7 Enter the rest of the Media information.

Video Embedding

- 8 In the **Code** field, copy and paste the embed code of the video.

Save the Activity

- 9 Click **Save**.

Tips and Hints

- 1 Set a prerequisite for a Multi-Media Activity by clicking the **Add Prerequisite** button. This allows you to specify a Test or QAssessment that your students must complete before they can attempt the new activity.
- 2 Use Studywiz Multi-Media Activity to provide reference material for your students. This way you can track which students are doing their research!
- 3 Embed video from websites such as youtube, teachertube, or google videos to allow students to watch your selected movie without visiting those websites.
