Embedding and Downloading

Embed a YouTube or Google Video

There are two ways to present video in Studywiz – they can be embedded or downloaded. The best method to use depends on the source of the video.

YouTube and Google videos have to be embedded using the code they provide. Some other videos can be downloaded and saved within Studywiz itself.

YouTube and Google both provide embedding code that can be used in Studywiz. All you need to do is get the code and paste it into the Studywiz Rich Text Editor using the HTML tool.

- 1 Open the video that you want to embed.
- 2 In YouTube, beneath the video, click **Share**, and then click **Embed**, or in Google Video, beneath the video, click **Embed Video**.
- 3 Copy the embed code from the box. Make sure that you get all the code.
- 4 In Studywiz, navigate to a location that uses the Rich Text Editor. This could be an Activity, or a Class or Group Information Page.
- 5 In the Studywiz Rich Text Editor, click the **HTML** button.
- 6 Paste the 'iframe' code into the HTML Source Editor panel.
- 7 Click **Update** and then save the Activity or page.

Presenting Video Files

Download a Video File

Some sources of video allow you to download and save a video file locally. You can then upload the video into Studywiz. This is often the best method of providing a video, as it is stored within Studywiz, and does not rely on the resource remaining online at the original source.

Federation and Defending Our Shores is an excerpt from the film *Cavalcade of Australia 1901-1951* (34 mins), produced in 1951. *Cavalcade of Australia 1901-1951*: Produced by the Australian National Film Commission to celebrate the Jubilee of Federation, *Cavalcade of Australia 1901-1951* is an historical review of the development of the nation between 1901 and 1951. The film opens with the visit of the Duke and Duchess of York (later King George V and Queen Mary) to Australia in 1901 to open the first Commonwealth Parliament.
